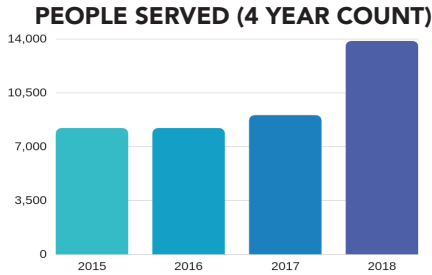


# SonBridge Fact Sheet - 2018



## Our Approach

## Volunteers

With volunteer labor valued in Washington state at \$30.46/hour, our largest group of supporters, the volunteers, give over \$36,000 monthly. This figure is based on the minimum commitment requirement asked of our volunteers of 3 hours per week, but many of our volunteers give time above and beyond this minimum on a regular basis.

- 1) The Thrift & Gift Store, 2) Individuals and families, 3) Trusts and foundations.

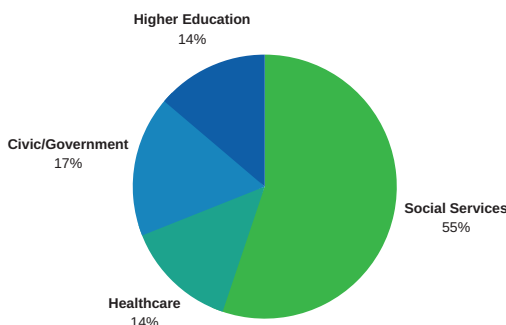
## Store

The Thrift & Gift Store provides the funds to enable the operation of the facility. Sales exceeded \$445,000 last year.

## History

SonBridge Community Center was founded in 2004 by Village Church Seventh-day Adventists who recognized the importance of direct access to low-cost community services. In 2005, facilitated by local Adventist congregations, SonBridge purchased a vacant nursing home in College Place, adjacent to Walla Walla city limits. In 2017, an additional 5,000 square feet was added, named the Education Center for Better Living, tripling our meeting spaces and expanded our capacity to serve our Valley.
